

# Orlando Project Packing List

## **IMPORTANT!!! - (Must have the following upon arrival to OP)**

1. \$1000 for first rent
2. Original Social Security Card (no copies allowed, cannot be laminated)
3. Driver's license
4. Voided check or official document given by your bank for direct deposit (to be eligible for direct deposit)
5. Bring money to live off of for the first two weeks. You will likely not get a full check for 2 weeks.

## **Other Important information:**

- Bring your car....driving is the best option!
- Chip in for gas if you are riding with someone.  
*(It costs about \$150 per car for gas, so make sure to split the cost if you're riding with someone)*
- If you are flying you need to find your own transportation to the hotel.

## **PACKING:**

### **Clothing**

- Pack for about two weeks. You will be able to wash your clothes. You will be wearing mostly athletic clothes.
- Outfit for *professional* interview with SeaWorld
  - Ladies (must have)**
    - One interview outfit
    - Two other business casual outfits for orientation (*pants/comfortable walking shoes for 2nd day of orientation*)
    - **Must have close-toed shoes for both the interview and orientation!!**
  - Guys (must have)**
    - One interview outfit (*tie, dress pants, and dress shirt*)
    - Two other business casual outfits for orientation (*no jeans!! Khakis and polo*)
    - **Must have close-toed shoes for both the interview and orientation!!**
- Church clothes
  - Ladies**
    - Dresses, dress pants, skirts
  - Guys**
    - Khakis, polos, dress shirts, ties
- Athletic clothes (*t-shirt, shorts, tank tops*)
- 1-2 long-sleeved shirts, a hoodie or two, and a light jacket (*Don't stress about bringing tons to wear on "days when it gets cold" - that rarely happens*)

- Underwear and socks (*Make sure you pack both black and white ankle socks, if you have any, because you will need one or the other for work*)
- A few casual tops / tank tops
- 1-2 pairs of jeans and a few pairs of shorts
- Bathing suit / cover up
- Shoes (*Dress shoes, Flip flops, Tennis shoes. Also, if you have white and/or black comfy tennis shoes, bring them for work.*)
- Beach towels

### **Hygiene**

- Shampoo and conditioner
- Soap / body wash
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush and toothpaste / floss
- Contact case / solution / glasses
- Face wash
- Razor / shaving cream
- Sunscreen
- Hair dryer / flat iron / curling iron
- Gel / Hairspray
- Hair brush / comb

### **Other**

- Bible, pens, notebook
- Basic first aid - Band aids, tylenol, etc.
- Umbrella
- Beach bag / bag to carry bible and books
- Coffee Mug
- Water bottle
- Plastic cup, Plate, bowl, utensils
- Laundry bag
- Sunglasses
- Storage for clothes (wire storage / plastic drawers)
- Pillow or blanket
