# Important!!! (MUST have the following upon arrival)

- 1. \$1,000 for first rent
- 2. Original Social Security Card (no copies allowed)
- 3. Drivers license
- 4. Voiced check for direct deposit
- 5. Money to live off of for the first two weeks (won't get paid for two weeks)

# Other important

- Bring your car....driving is the best option!
  - Chip in for gas if you are riding with someone.
  - Will cost around \$150 per car for gas
- If you are flying you need to find your own transportation to the hotel.

**Clothing** - Make sure to pack for about two weeks. You will be able to wash your clothes. You will most likely be wearing athletic/summer clothes.

- For Monday June 5th dress professionally
  - Ladies
    - One interview outfit
    - Two other business casual outfits for orientation (pants/comfortable shoes for 2nd day of orientation -- you will be riding rides and walking)
    - Must have close-toed shoes for both the interview and orientation!!
  - Men
    - One interview outfit (tie, dress pants, and dress shirt)
    - Two business casual outfits for orientation
      - Khaki pants and polo
      - NO JEANS!

  - Ladies- Dresses, dress pants, and skirts
  - Men- khaki pants and polos

### Other clothing items to bring

- Athletic clothes (t-shirt, shorts, tank tops)

- Underwear and socks for two weeks
  - Pack both black and white ankle socks for work
