

Important!!! (MUST have the following upon arrival)

1. \$1,000 for first rent
2. Original Social Security Card (no copies allowed)
3. Drivers license
4. Voiced check for direct deposit
5. Money to live off of for the first two weeks (won't get paid for two weeks)

Other important

- Bring your car....driving is the best option!
 - Chip in for gas if you are riding with someone.
 - Will cost around \$150 per car for gas
- If you are flying you need to find your own transportation to the hotel.

Clothing - Make sure to pack for about two weeks. You will be able to wash your clothes. You will most likely be wearing athletic/summer clothes.

For Universal Studios

- For Monday June 5th dress professionally
 - Ladies
 - One interview outfit
 - Two other business casual outfits for orientation (pants/comfortable shoes for 2nd day of orientation -- you will be riding rides and walking)
 - Must have close-toed shoes for both the interview and orientation!!
 - Men
 - One interview outfit (tie, dress pants, and dress shirt)
 - Two business casual outfits for orientation
 - Khaki pants and polo
 - NO JEANS!

For church

- For Monday June 5th dress professionally
 - Ladies- Dresses, dress pants, and skirts
 - Men- khaki pants and polos

Other clothing items to bring

- Athletic clothes (t-shirt, shorts, tank tops)
- 1-2 long-sleeved shirts, a hoodie or two, and a light jacket (Don't stress about bringing tons to wear on "days when it gets cold"... that rarely happens)
- Underwear and socks for two weeks
 - Pack both black and white ankle socks for work

- A few casual tops / tank tops
- 1-2 pairs of jeans and a few pairs of shorts
- Bathing suit / cover up
- Shoes (Dress shoes, Flip flops, Tennis shoes)
 - Also, if you have white and/or black comfy tennis shoes, bring them for work.
- Beach towels

Hygiene

- Shampoo and conditioner
- Soap / body wash
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush and toothpaste / floss
- Contact case / solution / glasses
- Face wash
- Razor / shaving cream
- Sunscreen
- Hair dryer / flat iron / curling iron
- Gel / Hairspray
- Hair brush / comb

Other

- Bible, pens, notebook
- Basic first aid - Band aids, tylenol, etc.
- Umbrella and/or rain coat (it rains for a short period almost every day)
- Beach bag / bag to carry bible and books
- Coffee Mug
- Water bottle
- Plastic cup, Plate, bowl, utensils
- Mini fridge
- Microwave
- InstantPot/George Foreman/Air Fryer (if wanting to cook in room)
- Laundry bag
- Sunglasses
- Storage for clothes (wire storage / plastic drawers)
- Pillow or blanket
- Any medications (enough for two months; usually can refill in Orlando if needed)
